A. March Board Meeting Presentation: Drinking Water 123 and Regional Housing Solutions Metropolitan Planning Council (MPC) Senior Advisor Nancy Firfer and Manager Danielle Gallet introduced two new resources for municipal officials. Ms. Firfer addressed housing challenges throughout the Chicago region and distributed information on Regional Housing Solutions.
