This letter is to inform you that the Governing Board of the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative has approved the first of three possible, one-year contract extensions on on the 2024 Ford Escape AWD Active (SE Trim) Contract (#206) with Currie Motors. There is a at a \$2,980.00 price increase over the 2022 model, with a \$1,100.00 government reduction, so incentive proposed pricing is \$29,028.00.

With acceptance of this contract extension, Currie Motors agrees to all terms and conditions set forth in the specifications contained within the Request for Proposals to which you responded. . The SPC reserves the right to extend this contract for up to two (2) additional one-year terms upon mutual agreement of both the vendor and the SPC on a negotiated basis.

Currie Motors Ford, Frankfort will handle all billing. Each vehicle will be assessed an administrative fee of \$150.00 per vehicle, which shall be paid directly by the vendor to the SPC on a quarterly basis.
