IV. Approval of Meeting Minutes – December 9, 2020

Motion to approve the minutes of December 9 was made by President Levin. It was seconded by Mayor McLeod and unanimously approved.

V. President's Report – Kathleen O'Hara, NWMC President and President, Village of Lake Bluff

A. COVID-19/NWMC Here to Help Update

Mr. Fowler gave an update on the status of state COVID-19 mitigations, the NWMC Here to Help update, the work of the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus Regional COVID Task Force and the status of federal COVID-19 stimulus legislation. Commissioner Britton explained the challenges the county is experiencing with the vaccine distribution and site implementation planning. He noted that the county would have a vaccine registry website up and running by the end of the month. Mr. Fowler offered to survey the NWMC Cook County members to identify large scale vaccination distribution sites and share that information with the county.

VI. Priority Issues

A. Legislative Committee – Joan Frazier, President, Village of Northfield, Co- Chair and Nancy Rotering, Mayor, City of Highland Park, Co-Chair

1. 2021 NWMC Legislative Program

President Frazier gave an overview of the NWMC 2021 Legislative Program components, noting the overarching need for assistance in dealing with the pandemic. President O'Hara said that the Legislative Committee and Executive Board recommended approval of the program. Motion to approve the recommendation was made by President Levin. It was seconded by Mayor McLeod and unanimously approved.

2. 2021 NWMC Legislative Program Introduction/Subregional Legislative Dialog

Mr. Fowler reported that, in lieu of the traditional NWMC Legislative Brunch, the Legislative Committee recommended introducing the 2021 Legislative Program via subregional video conferences following the current legislator outreach model. Motion to approve the recommendation was made by President Levin. It was seconded by Mayor Dailly and unanimously approved.

3. 2021 General Assembly Calendar

Mr. Bury reported that the Senate released their 2021 legislative calendar, which includes

dates for the Governor's budget and state of the state addresses and legislative deadlines. He reported on the January 8-13 "lame duck" session of the General Assembly. He reviewed details of events that took place January 13 in Springfield, which included passing of HB163/HB3653 and the election of new House Speaker Chris Welch.

B. Transportation Committee – Rodney Craig, President, Village of Hanover Park, Co-Chair and Tom Dailly, President, Village of Schaumburg, Co-Chair

Mr. Pasquini reported on NWMC state and federal legislative programs to address capital investments in infrastructure and multimodal transportation. President Craig reported that Metra recently approved \$1.8 billion to purchase new rail cars.

VII. Other Business

Mayor Dailly requested additional information on new House Speaker Chris Welch and suggested that the Conference should seek to meet with him. Mr. Fowler said he would contact Anderson Legislative Consulting and request that they arrange a meeting.

The Board returned to open session at 8:29 p.m. President Frum moved to approve the recommendation, which was seconded by President Craig. Ms. Neukirch asked if they would amend their motion to include a report on the compensation amount as suggested by Mayor Juracek. Both agreed and the motion was approved by a roll call vote of 20-7-1.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by President Levin. It was seconded by President Craig and unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
