I. Call to Order/Introductions

Mr. Peebles called the meeting to order at 10:34 a.m. and Ms. Johnson read the names of those attending the video conference.

II. Approval of August 11, 2020 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Buehler moved approval of the August 11, 2020 meeting minutes. Mr. Simmons seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

III. Virtual Field Trip Discussion

Mr. Peebles facilitated a discussion about the virtual field trip he planned for members of the committee prior to the meeting. Mr. Peebles discussed how the field trip consists of a bike ride along the North Shore Channel Trail accompanied by helpful resources and marked points of interest for participants to ride the route individually at their own leisure. Members of the committee who completed the bike ride shared their observations and perspectives on what made the ride enjoyable

and how it could have been improved. Mr. Peebles ended the discussion by giving a brief overview of each of the field trips points of interest.

IV. Local Project/Multimodal Plan Updates

Mr. Knapp reported that the Village of Schaumburg is in the middle of a make-shift bike month. Mr. Knapp also shared that the village is three weeks into their bicycle business challenge and noted a relatively high level of participation within the community.

Mr. Simmons reported that the side path along Biesterfield is nearly complete. Mr. Simmons also reported the Village of Elk Grove Village's bike plan is experiencing minor revisions but will be available soon. Finally, Mr. Simmons discussed a bike donation program the Village planned with West Town Bikes to help get bikes into the hands of people in underserved communities.

Ms. Schwab reported that the Village of Arlington Heights' Buffalo Creek Trail project is on hold because the village having difficulty obtaining the necessary permits from Cook County.

Ms. Beckner reported that the Village of Mount Prospect is installing bike repair station in their downtown. Ms. Beckner also reported a public meeting for Phase I of the Algonquin Road bike path project on September 29 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Ms. Johnson asked members of the committee if anyone's communities are submitting applications for the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program. The City of Des Plaines, Village of Hoffman Estates, Village of Northbrook and Village of Schaumburg affirmed they're applying and discussed some of the nuances of the application process.

V. Local Responses to COVID-19

Mr. Peebles reported that the City of Des Plaines' resident group noted positively that more people are walking and biking around the City, but also noted some restaurants in the downtown have closed.

VI. Other Business

Mr. Peebles announced that he is leaving his job with the City of Des Plaines and stepping down as co-chair of the committee.
