Call to Order/Introductions

Mr. Buehler, standing in for Trustee Porter, called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m.

Approval of December 10, 2024 Meeting Minutes

The meeting minutes were corrected to indicate that Mr. Beladi is representing the Village of Northbrook.

Mayor Sanoica moved approval of the December 10, 2024 meeting minutes. Ms. Applegate seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Winter Bike-Ped Infrastructure Maintenance

Mr. Czarnota and Mr. Larson presented findings from NWMC surveys regarding contractual snow plowing and sidewalk snow removal and facilitated a discussion on the successes and challenges municipalities encounter when addressing winter weather impacts on bike and ped infrastructure. Mr. Larson also highlighted a recent Federal Highway Administration guide on maintenance best practices.

MEMBERS Antioch ATTACHMENT A Mr. Buehler asked if the surveys captured different responses depending on type of use. Mr. Czarnota responded that snow removal questions were generalized, with questions divided between road and sidewalk facilities.

Ms. FioRito noted the Chicago sidewalk clearance pilot and wondered whether any communities had analyzed how to adopt a similar municipal-wide program. Mr. Larson mentioned some non-NWMC member communities in the region which have municipal-wide programs. Mr. Czarnota stated that the NWMC could research municipal programs on behalf of the membership. Ms. Tittle noted that Elk Grove Village's analysis of a municipal ice clearance program would require doubling of manpower, but resident interest is increasing. Ms. Tittle asked if a survey could be developed on what areas are being cleared and how communities enforce property owner clearance requirements.

Mayor Sanoica inquired about communities' experience with inter-governmental agreements (IGA) for facility maintenance, as most of the trails in Rolling Meadows are on park district property. Ms. Tittle mentioned that Elk Grove Village has an IGA with the township for snowplowing. Mayor Sanoica noted that forest preserves and park district facilities close after sundown which then limits those paths as a network connection. Mr. Schroth shared that Palatine has an IGA with their park district and school district to ensure routes are open and clear.

Ms. Applegate shared that Schaumburg is developing a new bike path along Schaumburg Road and Martingale Road and will have an open house on Wednesday February 12.

Mayor Sanoica reported attending preconstruction meetings with IDOT on the Illinois Route 53 bridge replacement.
