Ш. **Lessons Learned Living Abroad Presentation**

Former Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee Co-Chair and Des Plaines Civil Engineer Derek Peebles gave a presentation on observations from spending a year living abroad as it relates to planning and bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure. He shared his experiences from time spent in Albania, Estonia, Dubai and the Netherlands and some of the unique ways that their history shaped the way cities were developed and how it influences local planning today.

Based on Mr. Peebles presentation, Committee members asked about the following: the weather in Dubai and how that affected getting around on foot or bicycle; how brick pavers tend to hold up against snow removal equipment; bike theft issues in the Netherlands; and, the availability of short and long term bike rental options throughout the trip.

V. Local Project Updates

Ms. Hyink announced that Evanston has received an RTA Access to Transit grant to convert flagged bus stops to posted stops with ADA compliant pads. She noted that Phase II work would begin pending the approval of the intergovernmental agreement with the RTA. Ms. Beckner asked if certain stops were being targeted and Ms. Hyink explained that the project intends to convert as many stops as possible, but that certain locations on IDOT routes could prove more difficult to convert.

Mr. Simmons reported that Elk Grove Village recently updated its Bike Plan including revisions to the bike route network. He noted that a bike path along Meacham Road is in the planning stages. Mr. Simmons also provided updates from Ride Illinois regarding the Illinois Bike Summit in Urbana on October 12. He noted that Ride Illinois will continue to provide free bicycle friendly driver virtual courses approximately once per month and that more information was available on their website. Finally, Mr. Simmons reported that Ride Illinois is working with the Active Transportation Alliance and other advocacy organizations to draft a letter to Governor Pritzker and IDOT highlighting the importance of bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure projects in advance of Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act funding becoming available.

Ms. Beckner reported that Mount Prospect received CMAQ funding for the completion of the Algonquin Road shared use path. Mr. Mangum announced that Lincolnwood village staff have been directed to research the possibility of an expansion of Divvy service to the Village. Ms. Johnson noted that staff has compiled the results of the annual Multimodal Plan survey and that staff would present a summary of the results at the March meeting. She reminded the Committee that the North Shore and Northwest Council calls for projects are open as well as Cook County's Invest in Cook program.
