Mr. Lysicatos also announced that he had taken a different job with Arlington Heights and Schaumburg would have a new representative on the committee.

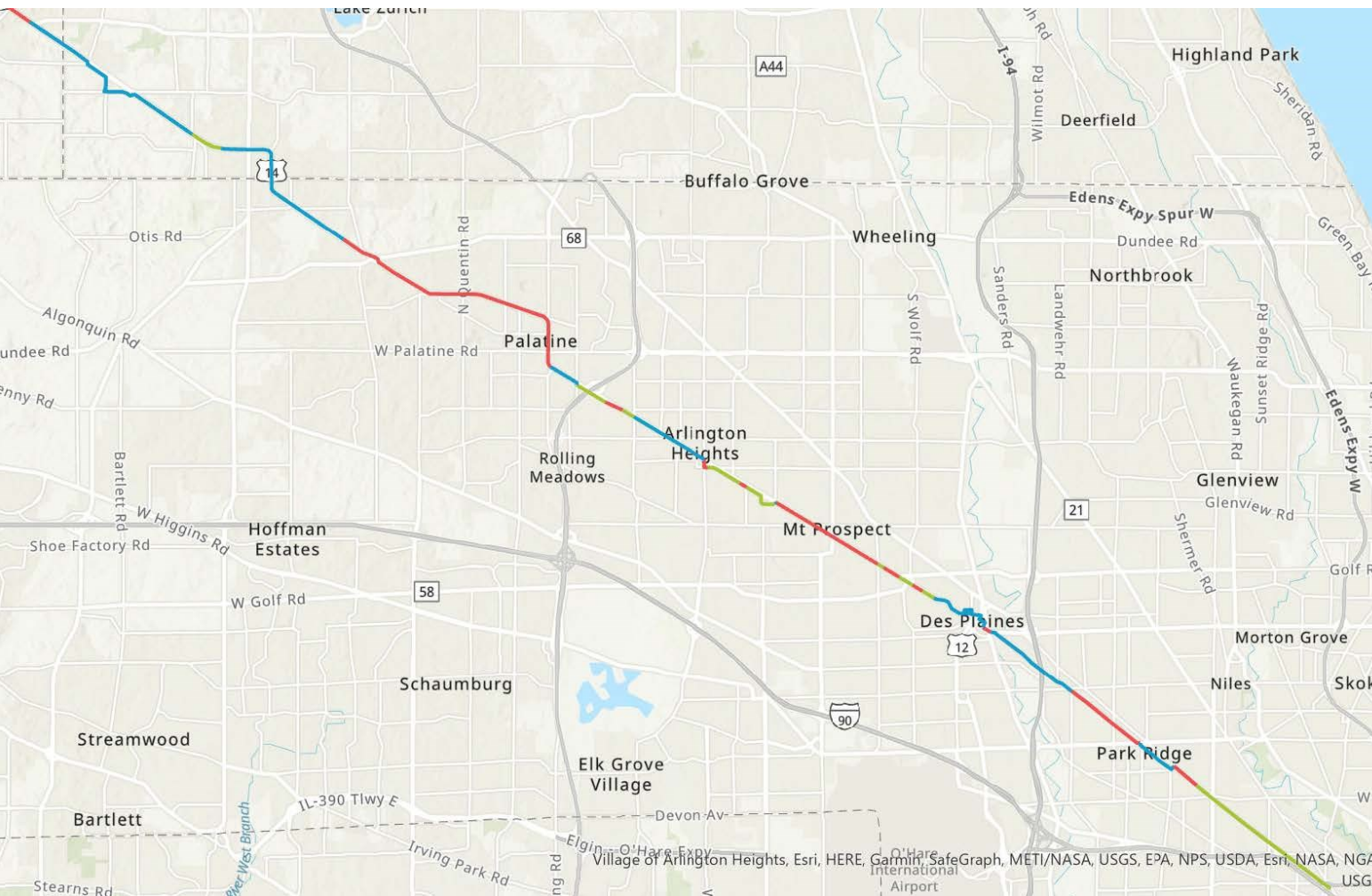
VII. Next Meeting

Northwest Bikeway



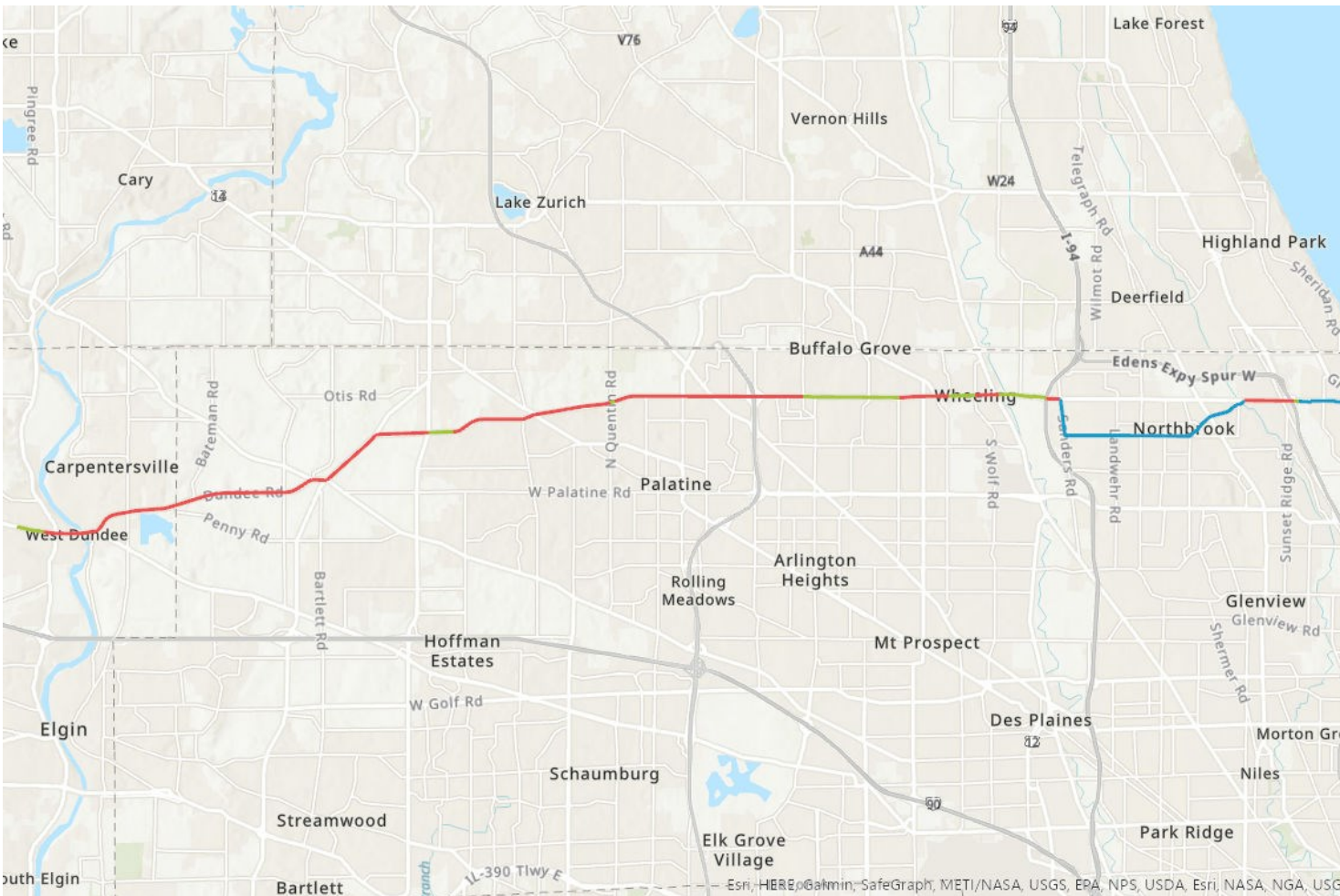
- Existing—6.32 mi

Dundee Road Bikeway



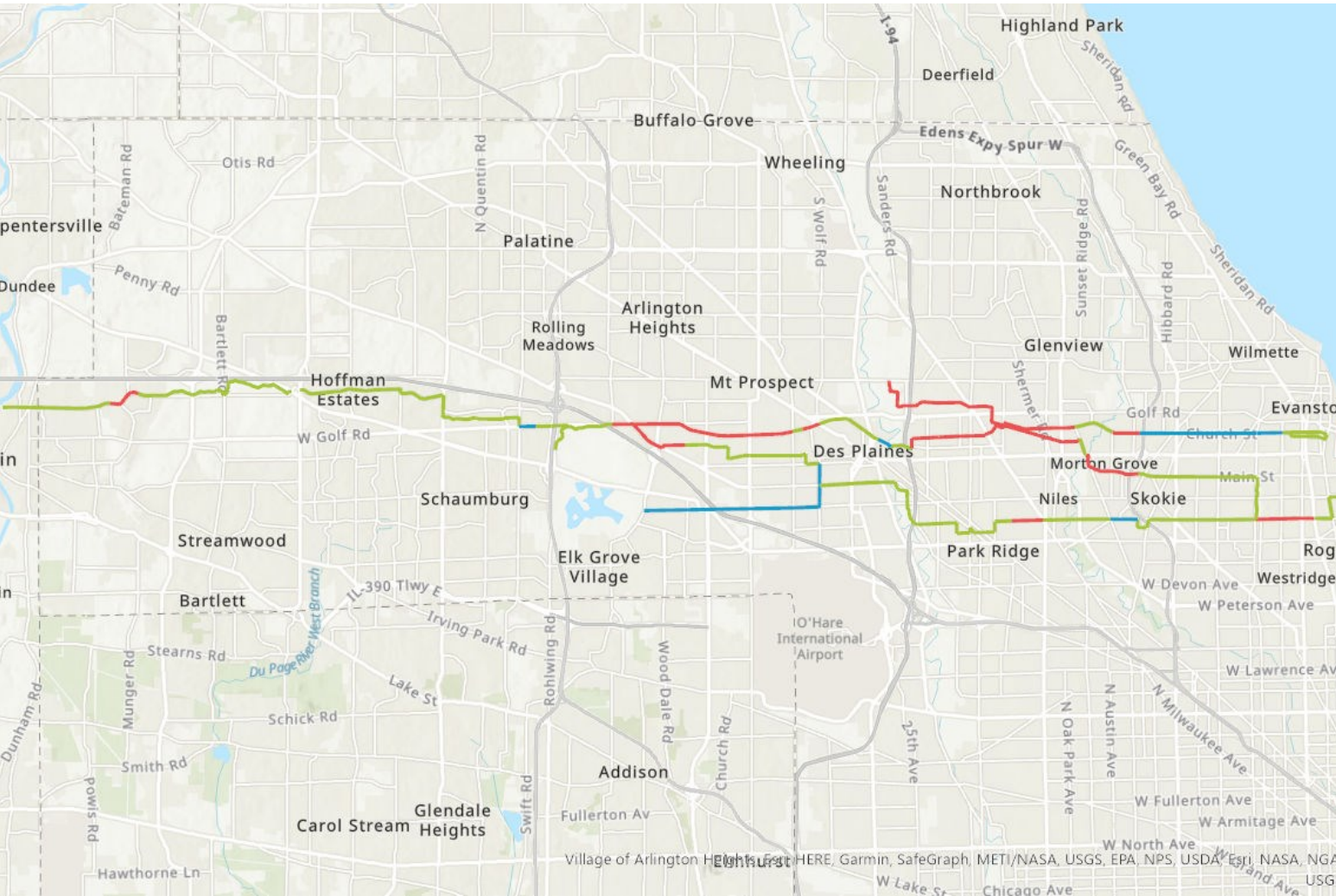
