She also reported that the Village received funding to begin work on Phase 1 along New Wilke Road to install a side path. Ms. Schwab reported that the Village will be hosting a community bike ride on June 4.

Ms. Johnson suggested having a round table discussion at the next meeting about different issues and planning procedures that members have regarding Bicycle and Pedestrian plans within their communities. She requested that anyone interested in participating and helping to lead the discussion reach out to staff via email. Mr. Baxa and Ms. Beckner both volunteered to participate in the discussion.
