He noted the plan is updated every 4 years He identified several projects in the plan that are already underway and a couple that Northbrook wants to start on in the future that helps the Village track its progress.

Jenny Horn reported that Hoffman Estates are in a similar position to Mount Prospect that they are trying to transition from a Bike Plan to a Multi Modal Plan.
