#### I. Call to Order

Mr. Cook called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

#### II. Approval of Minutes

Mr. Cook asked if there were any changes to the September 28, 2016 minutes. On a motion by Mr. Bernahl, seconded by Mr. Jensen, the committee approved the minutes as presented.

# III. Agency Reports

## a. Pace

Mr. Pigeon reported on the status of Pace's I-90 Market Expansion program which would introduce six new routes, improved service on five existing routes, new park and ride facilities and new 40' busses with Wifi and charging ports.

## b. IDOT Highways Report

No report.

#### c. Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways Mr. Schmitz distributed the status sheets for Cook County highway projects.

**d.** Illinois Tollway No report.

# e. Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP)

Mr. Pigeon reported on the status of the US DOT's recent rule on MPO coordination and its potential effect on the Chicago region. He also described upcoming U.S. Census workshops being held by CMAP.

# f. IDOT Local Roads

Mr. Fierro distributed the IDOT local roads status sheets and described any changes.

# IV. North Shore Council of Mayors Surface Transportation Program (STP)

# A. North Shore Council STP (FFY17-21)

Mr. Pigeon described the status of the current North Shore STP noting that the council would end the fiscal year with a negative balance. He also described options available to reduce the size of the annual program. Mr. Bernahl noted that Winnetka's Willow Road project was not moving forward and the Village would be willing to remove it from the program.

# B. Advanced Funding for FFY2017

Mr. Pigeon described the status of the Council's advanced funding noting that all projects slated for construction up to the June 2017 letting had been accounted for.

# V. Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ)

## a. CMAQ Program Update

Mr. Pigeon described the current North Shore CMAQ program. He described the upcoming call for CMAQ and TAP projects and how the draft application differed from previous applications. He encouraged project sponsors to schedule Phase I kick-off meetings with IDOT to ensure Phase I would be completed by June 1, 2017, in accordance with CMAQ guidelines. Mr. Kenny asked for clarification on the phase I requirements.

# VI. Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP)

Mr. Pigeon provided and update on the North Shore Council ITEP program as outlined in the spreadsheet.

# VII. Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) and Safe Routes to School

Mr. Pigeon provided an update on current TAP and SRTS projects.

## VIII. North Shore Council of Mayors Annual Report

Mr. Pigeon presented the draft FFY 2016 annual report to the committee. Mr. Kenney noted one error. On a motion by Mr. Kramer, seconded by Mr. Jensen, the committee voted to approve the annual report with the correction noted by Mr. Kenney.

# IX. IDOT Functional Classification Review

Mr. Pigeon described the status of IDOT's review of the functional classifications of the region's roadways. He thanked the committee for submitting their comments and provided a timeline for when the review would be complete.

# X. Other Business

Mr. Bernahl asked if the Council would submit joint comments to the MWRD regarding proposed changes to the Watershed Management Ordinance (WMO). Mr. Cook asked when the open houses would be held. Mr. Pigeon replied that the proposed changes would be described in detail at the watershed planning council meetings in January and March. Mr. Cook suggested that the Council should submit joint comments.

## XI. Next Meeting

Mr. Cook noted that the next meeting was scheduled for March 22.

## XII. Adjournment

The committee unanimously voted to adjourn.
