I. Call to Order

Mr. Cook called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

II. Approval of Minutes

Mr. Cook asked if there were any changes to the March 23 or April 20 minutes. Mr. Gutierrez noted that he was present at the April 20 meeting. One a motion by Ms. Van Dornick, seconded by Mr. Jensen, the committee votes to approve the minutes with the edits noted by Mr. Gutierrez.

III. Agency Reports

a. Pace

Mr. Andrews reported that the second meeting of the Pulse Dempster Line corridor advisory group would be held June 29. He further reported that the CTA/Pace North Shore Coordination study survey was live.

b. IDOT Highways Report

Ms. Hooghkirk distributed the IDOT Highways status sheets noting that the MYP for 2017-2022 had been announced and all new projects were noted on the sheets. Mr. Amelio asked about the looming state shutdown. Ms. Hooghkirk did not have any details.

c. Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways

Mr. Schmitz distributed the status sheets for Cook County highway projects.

- d. Illinois Tollway No report.
- e. Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) No report.

f. IDOT Local Roads

Mr. Fierro distributed the IDOT local roads status sheets and described any changes.

g. Mr. Pigeon reported that IDOT recently announced that without a state appropriation by July 1, it would order all agencies to cease construction activities on state let projects and require work zones to be secured for an indefinite period of time. Mr. Tomich asked if the directive applied to design work. Mr. Pigeon did not know but would share any additional information with the committee as it became available.

IV. North Shore Council of Mayors Surface Transportation Program (STP)

A. North Shore Council STP (FFY16-20)

Mr. Pigeon described the status of the current North Shore STP noting that the council would end the fiscal year with a slight positive balance pending the proposed modifications.

B. North Shore Council STP FFY2016-2019

1. Program Modification Request from the Village of Wilmette

Mr. Pigeon described the modification request to the Skokie/Hibbard intersection project and its effect on the 2016 STP program, funding history and nature of the request. He noted that he recommended moving Wilmette's Locust Rd project back to accommodate the Skokie/Hibbard request. Mr. Jensen described the reason for the request. On a motion by Mr. Gutierrez, seconded by Mr. Tomich, the council approved the modification requests.

V. Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ)

a. CMAQ Program Update

Mr. Pigeon described the current North Shore CMAQ program noting the projects that had been moved out of deferment and into the current program and projects with sunset years in 2016. He noted that a call for CMAQ and TAP projects would open in

January of 2017 and he would make the draft application available to the committee as soon as it was available.

VI. Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP)

Mr. Pigeon provided and update on the North Shore Council ITEP program as outlined in the spreadsheet noting that Glenview and Northbrook recently held a meeting to discuss Phase I of the Shermer Rd. bike path.

VII. Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) and Safe Routes to School

Mr. Pigeon provided an update on current TAP and SRTS projects noting that the Evanston speed sign project recently held a Phase II Kick off.

VIII. FAU Reclassification Request from Village of Lincolnwood

Mr. Pigeon described the Village of Lincolnwood's request to reclassify Lawndale Avenue, Central Park Avenue and Northeast Parkway as a Major Collector. Mr. Amelio described the reasons for the request, citing the volume of commercial traffic along that route. Mr. Tomich asked if Major Collector was an appropriate designation for that route. Ms. Van Dornick asked about traffic studies along the corridor. Mr. Amelio said that industrial development was driving the traffic and for that reason the Village felt the Major Collector designation was appropriate. On a motion by Ms. Van Dornick, seconded by Ms. Chen, the committee approved the request.

IX. Other Business

Mr. Pigeon informed the committee he would be on vacation at the end of July and beginning of August and asked the committee to submit any agreements before then. He noted that his colleague Michael Walczak would be available to assist during that time. Ms. Van Dornick announced she would be retiring at the end of the month.

X. Next Meeting

Mr. Cook noted that the next meeting was scheduled for September 28.

XI. Adjournment

On a motion by Ms. Van Dornick, the committee voted to adjourn at 8:45 a.m.

Three Percent Annual Cost Increase:

Annually, a three percent cost increase is applied to all projects in the North Shore STP. This increase adds \$746,421 to the active North Shore STP.

Background: October 1, 2015 marks the beginning of Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016. At the beginning of every FFY, the North Shore Council of Mayors Technical Committee reviews and edits its multiyear STP. In addition, at the beginning of each FFY, as a matter of policy, the North Shore Council approves a three percent cost increase for STP projects to account for inflation. The North Shore Council of Mayors ultimately approves the program

For construction funding, the North Shore Council will seek advance funding on a project following the submittal of pre-final plans. For Phase II Engineering and ROW acquisition, the North Shore Council will submit advanced funding requests following local execution of the Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation (BLR 05310).
