Mr. Cook called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

II. Approval of Minutes

Mr. Cook asked if there were any changes to the September 23 minutes. On a motion by Mr. Nagar, seconded by Mr. Jensen, the committee votes to approve the minutes as submitted.

III. Agency Reports

a. Pace

Mr. Andrews reported that the Pace board approved the agency's 2016 budget at its November meeting and the budget would be considered at the RTA Board meeting on December 17. He noted there would be a \$0.25 fare hike for customers paying with

cash. He described plans for increased wifi on buses well as the launch of the Ventra mobile app. 2016 projects would include the Pulse Milwaukee line, I-90 express buses and park and ride. He also noted that Pace would be conducting a market analysis of service in the North Shore region.

b. IDOT Highways Report

Mr. Pigeon distributed the IDOT Highways status sheets.

c. Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways

Ms. Choca Urban provided updates on the Cook County projects including a bridge over Lake Cook road for the Skokie Valley bike trail, Hibbard Road in Wilmette, Happ Road and the Old Orchard Road improvements in Skokie. She noted that the county was in the process of hiring new outreach staff who would be attending the March committee meeting.

d. Illinois Tollway

No report. Mr. Pigeon noted that Ms. Anderson had retired and was awaiting news of her replacement.

e. Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) No report.

f. IDOT Local Roads

Mr. Fierro distributed the IDOT local roads status sheets and described any changes.

A. North Shore Council STP (FFY16-19)

Background: As outlined in the attached memo, this project was on the March 4, 2016 construction letting. The low bid exceeded the engineer's estimate by approximately \$2.5 million. The City is requesting an additional \$844,837 in STP funds for FFY2016, a 44% increase.

At its December 17, 2014 meeting, the Technical Committee granted the City an increase of \$708,680 for Construction of this project in FFY 2016, a 39% increase over previous funding levels.

The North Shore Council's STP methodology states (p.14):

Project cost increases that exceed 20 percent of the programmed amount within a particular fiscal year will be subject to approval by the North Shore Council of Mayors via the Technical Committee. Approval will be contingent upon the following:

a. Programming constraints and funding availability within that fiscal year.
b. Special circumstances that resulted in an increase in project costs such as additional improvements that are being required by federal, state and/or county transportation agencies not considered in during the project scoping process.
c. Project sponsor has not petitioned the Council for cost increases for the same project during that particular fiscal year.²

²In the event that a project sponsor receives approval from the Council for a cost increase that exceeds 20 percent of the programmed amount, then any cost increases that arise thereafter for the same project during that fiscal year will be the responsibility of the local agency.

Therefore, due to methodology limits on cost increases, staff cannot recommend approval of this request. However, *The North Shore Council of Mayors has the authority to grant special exceptions to any of the above guidelines if in its opinion the circumstances so dictate* (Methodology Section VI).

Dear Mr. Pigeon:

The North Shore Council of Mayors has previously approved federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding for improvements to the complex intersection of Emerson Street / Ridge Avenue / Green Bay Road (ERGB Intersection Improvements). The maximum federal participation was not to exceed \$1,913,943 (70%). The purpose of the project is to address capacity deficiencies, improve traffic, bike and pedestrian safety, and reduce number of conflicts at the intersection. To do so, the project will modify the configuration of the Emerson, Ridge, and Green Bay Road intersections and simplify the traffic movements. This involves the reconstruction and realigning of these three roadways where they intersect and also includes traffic signal modernization, traffic signal interconnect, viaduct lighting and street lighting improvements. The proposed work will improve the levels of service at each intersection and improve pedestrian safety accommodations by adding crosswalks and sidewalk at several locations where they currently do not exist.

The project also includes improvements along the Green Bay Road corridor north of the intersection improvements at Emerson/Ridge/Green Bay. The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) approved federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding for this portion of the improvement. The maximum federal participation was not to exceed \$1,920,000 (80%). The purpose of the Green Bay Road Corridor improvements is to right-size the roadway. This involves reconfiguring the existing cross section from 4 lanes to 3 lanes - 2 through lanes separated by a two way left turn lane. Corridor improvements also include pavement resurfacing, traffic signal modernization, traffic signal interconnect, street lighting improvements, and streetscape/ landscaping. The proposed corridor work will improve traffic safety and improve the pedestrian environment.

The project was let through IDOT, and the bids opened on March 4, 2016. Of the ten contractors who picked up the bid documents, four of the contractors submitted bids. The

apparent low bidder, A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. submitted a bid in the amount of \$11,173,775.42. This bid exceeded the engineer's estimate of \$8,633,652.07 by \$2,540,123.35.

A comparison of the differences in costs by category follows:

The City of Evanston requests an additional \$844,837 in STP Funding (70% of total STP increase of \$1,206,866.41), which will be utilized for the ERGB Intersection Improvements. The City of Evanston will also seek additional CMAQ Funds through CMAP for the Green Bay Road Corridor Improvements.

Evanston believes that re-letting this project will not result in lower bids and it may even result in higher bids given that the start of the project would be delayed, and the construction need to be completed in the winter and spring months. We request that you consider the additional funding so that this project may proceed and remain on schedule to be substantially completed in 2016.
