I. Call to Order

Mr. Cook called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

II. Approval of Minutes

Mr. Cook asked if there were any changes to the September 27, 2017 minutes. On a motion by Mr. Tomich, seconded by Mr. Nagar the committee approved the minutes as presented.

III. Agency Reports

a. Pace

Mr. Pigeon reported on the Pace I-90 market expansion program and the Pulse Milwaukee and Dempster lines

e. Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP)

Mr. Ferguson reported on the recently approved STP agreement between the Council of Mayors and the City of Chicago. He described ongoing pavement condition data collection and described the call for pilot projects in CMAP's new municipal pavement management program. He noted that the call for projects would open January 22 and close in March. A webinar would be held on or around February 5.

Mr. Ferguson described the pavement management system. The committee also expressed concerns about projects that are delayed past 2020, cost increases and potential cost caps on new projects.

Mr. Pigeon described the current North Shore CMAQ program.

Mr. Pigeon provided and update on the North Shore Council ITEP program, TAP program and safe routes to schools program as outlined in the spreadsheet.

On February 28, the STP Project Selection Committee held its third meeting to discuss the new regional Shared Fund, which was created as part of the regional STP agreement last year. Local municipalities and the City of Chicago will be eligible to apply to the Shared Fund program. CMAP staff led a discussion on the possible types of projects eligible to be funded, minimum cost thresholds, and the program priorities.

Among the recommendations offered by CMAP staff at the meeting were to:

- Use the fund for projects that: make large and lasting contributions to regional priorities; help implement the ON TO 2050 regional comprehensive plan; meet potential demand from currently unfunded local projects; and, leverage and fill gaps between other fund sources. Recommended project types included: road reconstructions which also implement Complete Streets policies; transit station reconstructions; bridge replacement and reconstruction; grade separations; road expansion with transit preference and/or ITS improvements; bus speed improvements; corridor-level or small area safety improvements; and, truck route improvements.
- Fund only projects that either have a minimum project cost of \$5 million or projects that have at least three local sponsors.
- Create a rotating set of priorities for each call for projects, using the project types identified above. The rotation was proposed to allow a variety of project types to be considered for funding while avoiding wide-open calls for projects during each cycle.
- Allow Phase I Engineering to be funded only for high need communities. Additional phases may not be programmed until Phase I is complete.

Similar to the Active Program Management concept discussed at the January STP Project Selection Committee meeting, a draft proposal on the Shared Fund will be presented in two months after input from stakeholders. Final approval for both the Shared Fund and Active Program Management is slated for October, 2019.

Staff will provide additional details and discuss the implications of the proposals and our ongoing discussions with the other regional councils at the Board meeting.
