I. Call to Order/Introductions

Trustee Benton, filling in as Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

II. Approval of February 23, 2023 Meeting Minutes

Trustee Israel moved approval of the February 23, 2023 meeting minutes. Ms. Robles seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

III. Agency Reports

A. CMAP – Written report provided. Mr. Ferguson was available for any questions.

- B. Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways** – Ms. Diaz reported that the Invest in Cook application period had closed and sponsors of awarded projects should be notified within the next month.
- C. IDOT Highways** – Mr. Farmer shared that his report was similar to the last meeting, noting a few date changes.
- D. Illinois Tollway** – Written report provided.
- E. Metra** – Ms. Dote reported that Union Pacific Northwest line will be operating at an expanded schedule with an additional 12 weekday trains because of customer feedback.

Mr. Benton asked if the Union Pacific North will also get an expanded schedule. Ms. Dote said Metra is monitoring and will adapt the schedule as needed.

Mayor Craig discussed an upcoming press conference on the merger of Canadian Pacific and Kansas City Southern railroads.

- F. Pace** – Mr. Andrews reported that Pace will be hosting another Hire on the Spot event at their Arlington Heights headquarters. He also announced a new pilot program from the Palatine Metra station called Van Go that allows an individual to rent a Pace van to pool with others to jobs within 5 miles from the station.

Trustee Israel asked if Pace was having any issues with delivery of electric vehicles. Mr. Andrews answered that they haven't seen any issues with delays but that may be because the acquisition process is very gradual.

- G. RTA** – Mr. Whitehead reported that the RTA is working to educate elected officials and other stakeholders on future operating funding needed for the region's transportation system. He also said that RTA is working with CMAP on their PART plan.

IV. Cook County Transit Plan

Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways Transit Manager Benet Haller discussed outreach efforts, strategic recommendations and next steps related to the Cook County Transit Plan.

V. Meeting with IDOT Central Office Staff Recap

Staff summarized the meeting on March 14 between NWMC members, other council of government staff, regional stakeholders and IDOT Central Office Staff to discuss solutions to ongoing issues.

Mr. Dorsey said that while the presentation was a good start, he felt the relationship between IDOT and municipalities did not yet achieve the process described in the presentation.

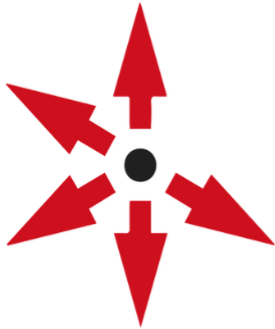

Finally, over the last few months and in the upcoming weeks, the CMAP team is intently focused on development of the [Plan of Action for Regional Transit \(PART\)](#). This includes engaging and collecting input from many stakeholder groups, including the PART Steering Committee, working groups, public focus groups, government partners, and more. CMAP is charged with submitting a plan to the governor and Illinois General Assembly at the beginning of next year with recommendations around reforms related to transit service, financing, and governance. The report will need to be approved by the CMAP Board and the MPO Policy Committee in October before being submitted to the Legislature.

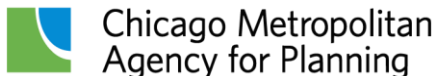

Strategic plan implementation kicks off with *Transit is the Answer* Coalition

In April, the RTA hosted a [Transit is the Answer Coalition kickoff](#) open house to connect and celebrate our collective work on the development of *Transit is the Answer*. The Coalition will advocate for sustainable transit funding and help shape the future of the system. The group of riders, advocates, agency staff, and community leaders will hold quarterly hourlong virtual meetings to develop and pursue strategies for strengthening the transit system and making it more useful for all residents. This initiative is a continuation of the robust engagement that informed the development of *Transit is the Answer*.

The Coalition held its first meeting on May 9 to receive an update on the RTA's planned 2023 activities and a discussion about a [potential program for expanded free or reduced transit fares](#) for people experiencing low incomes. Chairman Dillard was also [appointed to Mayor-Elect Brandon Johnson's Transition Team](#) as a co-chair of the Transportation Subcommittee. As the legislative session progresses in Springfield, RTA staff continues to monitor legislation that has the potential to impact transit and meet with members one-on-one to discuss *Transit is the Answer* and next steps for the legislative session.

This year's series will include topics in transportation planning as they relate to implementation of *Transit is the Answer*.
